Pregnancy

Dr. Reddy's Bosentan Film-coated Tablet may harm the development of the foetus. Therefore, you must not take Dr. Reddy's Bosentan Film-coated Tablet if you are pregnant and you must also not become pregnant while taking Dr. Reddy's Bosentan Film-coated Tablet. Moreover, if you are suffering from pulmonary hypertension disease, the occurrence of a pregnancy can severely deteriorate the symptoms of your disease. If you suspect you may be pregnant, tell your doctor or gynaecologist.

Contraception

Birth control based on hormones – such as oral contraceptives or birth control pills, hormone injections, implants, or birth control skin patches don't reliably prevent pregnancy in women who are taking Dr. Reddy's Bosentan Film-coated Tablet. You need to use a barrier form of birth control – like a condom, diaphragm or vaginal sponge – in addition to any of these kinds of hormonal birth control. Be sure to discuss any questions you may have with your doctor or your gynaecologist – complete the details on the back of this card and take it to your doctor or gynaecologist at your next visit.

You should have a pregnancy test before initiation of Dr. Reddy's Bosentan Film-coated Tablet and every month during the treatment even if you think that you are not pregnant.
