Missed doses, illness or surgery can cause adrenal crisis requiring emergency treatment. This patient is on long term treatment with AGAMREE (vamorolone), a dissociative corticosteroid for the chronic treatment of Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy, and therefore is physically **DEPENDENT** on daily steroid therapy as a critical medicine.

- If this patient is unwell (excess fatigue, unexpected weakness, vomiting, diarrhea, dizziness, or confusion), acute adrenal insufficiency or crisis must be taken into consideration.
- Acute adrenal crisis is an **EMERGENCY** and requires urgent medical attention by calling 999 or attending a hospital emergency department.
